I. Treasurer's Report

II. Funding Requests:

- a. Kim Kratzer is requesting up to \$1500 for table and chairs for the Parent Room **Vote Passed 10 Yes, 4 No**Discussion: Currently there are no chairs in our Parent Room. We have 3 glass tables and all chairs that were in there have broken and been thrown away. This room is one of the first things perspective families see when they come for a tour. The weather is getting colder and it would be nice to have a place for parents to sit at the end of the day. Nothing has been picked out yet. Kim does not intend to spend the entire amount, and the board will review any purchases. It was asked if a jeans day could be done to help cover the cost, but all jean days have been designated this school year.
- b. Ms. Morad is requesting \$1000 for an online program called Mouse Connect **Vote Passed**Discussion: Presented by Mrs. McKelvey, due to Ms. Morad's absence. The total cost will \$1500, however if this passes she will be using her \$500 PTO budgeted funds to put towards it. This program can be used by all grades.
